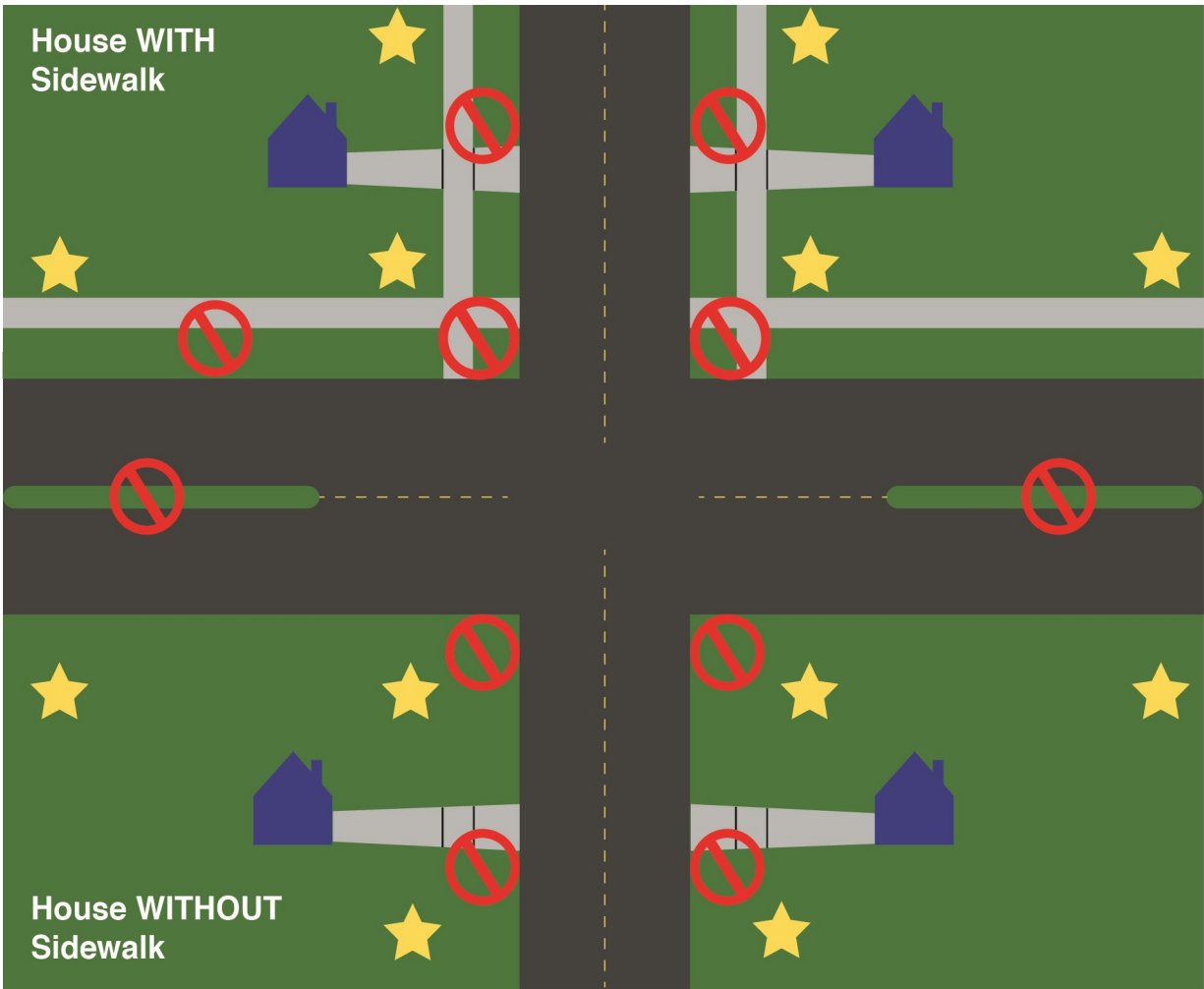


Wichita-Sedgwick Sign Placement Guide



The star ★ indicates acceptable sign placement.

The ⚡ indicates unacceptable sign placement.

Guidelines:

- Signs can only be placed on private property. **Never** in medians, in the public right-of-way, directly adjacent to the road, or hung on poles. No exceptions.
- Always ask for permission before placing signs on private property.
- Open house signs are only permitted at main entrances to the subdivision where the home is located, on private property only. Directional signs are permitted internally within the subdivision on private property only.
- Signs over 8 square feet are prohibited.

The above map is only a guideline.

Signs improperly placed on City rights of way or public property may be removed.
Any sign that is removed may be recovered with payment of a fee.
